

Common Core Unit - WPTCC08 - Street Works Supervision

This training specification has been developed from the water process technician standard. The specification details the **minimum** training specification, as agreed by industry employers, to deliver the skills and knowledge required to carry out street works supervision in the water sector.

The New Roads and Street Works Act 1991 (NRSWA), supported by relevant regulations and codes of practice, provides a legislative framework for street works by undertakers (including utility companies) and works for road purposes – to the extent that these must be co-ordinated by street authorities. The aim is to balance the statutory rights of highway authorities and undertakers to carry out works with the right of road users to expect the minimum disruption from works.

NRSWA Unit 10 is a code of practice specifically for monitoring of signing, lighting and guarding for utility works.

What does this specification look like?

Learners need to be able to:

SSG1 Supervise the installation and removal of signing, lighting and guarding, including installation of temporary traffic management systems

To complete this module you must:

Successfully complete the Unit 10 training and assessment delivered by an assessor registered with the Street Works Qualification Register (SWQR) and have been issued with a "red book" and identity card detailing the expiry date 5 years from delivery of training.

NRSWA Unit 10 – 1 Day Course and Assessment

The unit consists of a one day tutor led course with an end assessment and leads to NRSWA registration with SWQR for a period of 5 years. The unit provides a uniform approach to the monitoring of signing, lighting & guarding training across the utility sector.

Upon completion, all staff will be registered with the SWQR (Street Works Qualification Register) and will be issued with a registration card. Refresher training is required every 5 years to keep your certificate or card valid.

Upon successful completion of the course, participants should be able to:

• Supervise signing, lighting and guarding of road works as laid down in the safety at street works and road works code of practice



- Supervise the installation of portable traffic signals
- Undertake the assessment for unit 10 monitoring of signing lighting and guarding
