It is predicted that 221,000 vacancies will be created in the energy and utilities sector by 2025. With new people entering the sector, there is a continuing need to enhance basic behaviours, skills and awareness, ensuring the health and safety of both workers and the general public.

- Awareness/ familiarisation training for office based support staff
