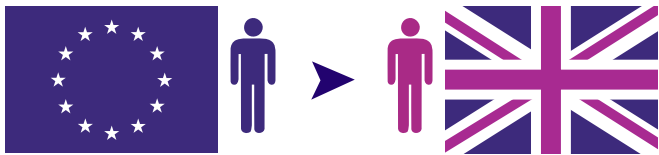


# LABOUR MARKET ANALYSIS TOWARDS BREXIT

As many as **65%** of the predicted vacancies in our sector will be required to come from the UK's general labour market. This graphic tracks the labour market movement as we progress to Brexit.

## Unemployment Levels



Unemployment levels are the lowest since 1975 at

**4.2%**

Less than **1%** people claiming Job Seeker's Allowance were seeking work in the energy-related occupations on the UK's Shortage Occupation List (**545 of 475,000**)

Highest level of employment since records began (1971) at

**75.7%**
