Apprenticeship Reform Policy Refinement and Evaluation

As we move into year 2 of the apprenticeship levy and reform implementation, we have seen further refinement to the funding policy and, from August 2018, there will be changes to the funding rules. In addition, the Education Select Committee has been scrutinising and evaluating the advancement made since the introduction of the apprenticeship reforms.

Earlier this month, the Department for Education published its Progress Report on the Apprenticeship Reform Programme' which summaries the progress made towards the success measures it committed to. It sets out the policy for apprenticeship funding in England from August 2018 and updates the policy that has been in place since May 2017.

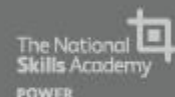
