Sign up for the Procurement Skills Accord 2019/20 is now open

Sector employers are being encouraged to consider signing up to an initiative that has helped leading UK gas, power, water and waste companies drive investment in training and skills, in areas where the sector needs them most, through procurement.

The Procurement Skills Accord was created in response to the 2015 National Infrastructure Plan for Skills, as a mechanism to incentivise skills investment through procurement and engagement approaches that would provide appropriate incentives to retrain and upskill the workforce to meet future skills demands.

The deadline to sign up for the 2019/20 Procurement Skills Accord is 30 September 2019.
