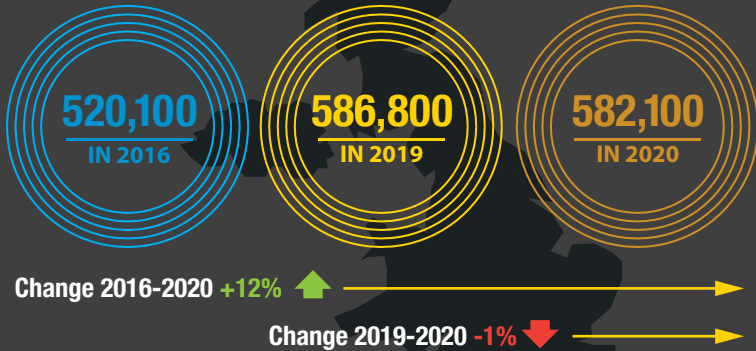
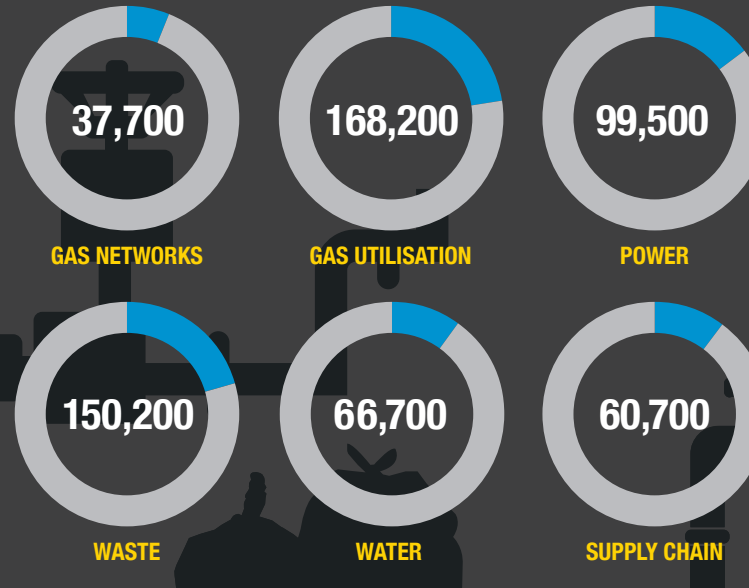

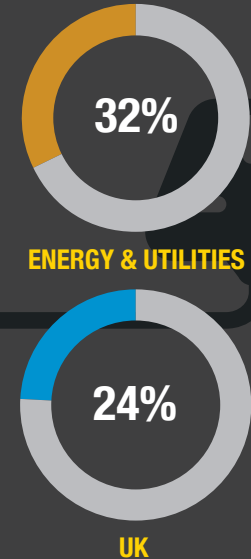

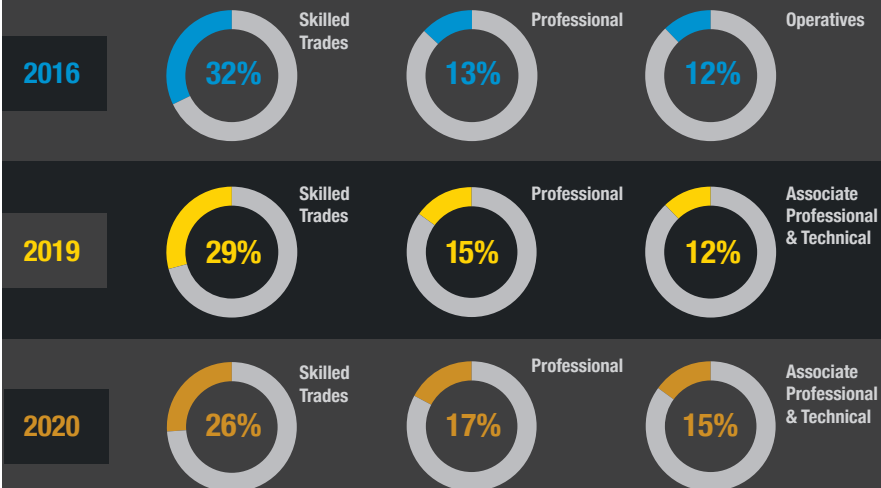


% OF VACANCIES THAT ARE SKILLS SHORTAGES 2019:

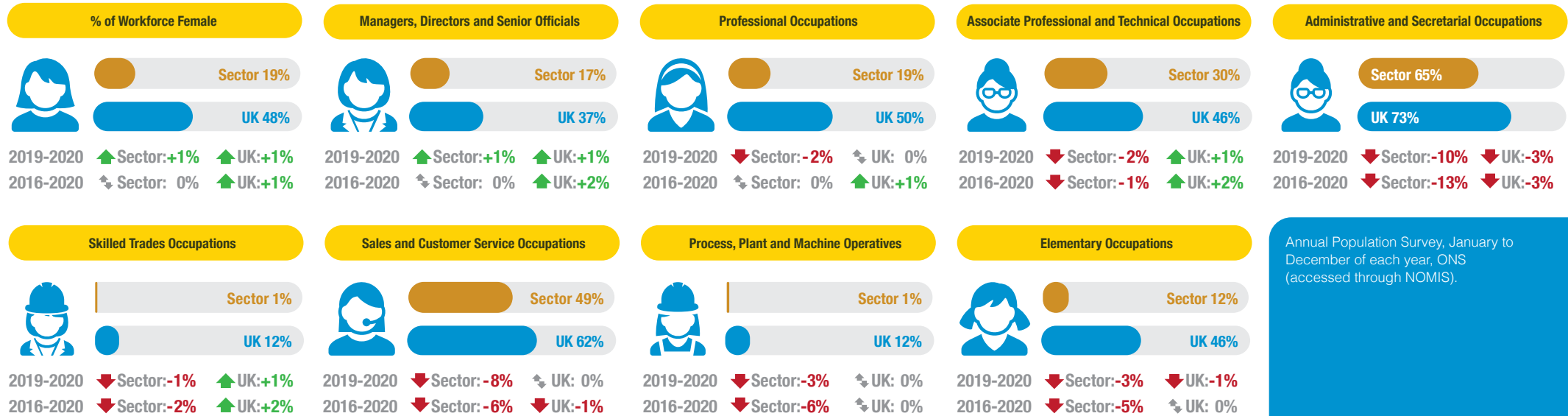
Forecast number of vacancies 2020-2029

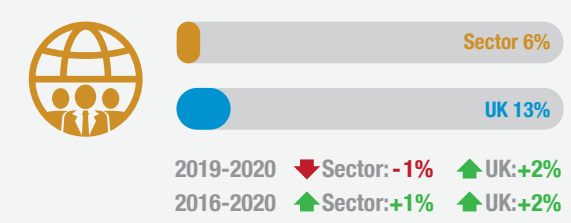


Percentage of Energy & Utilities Sector Workforce - Female

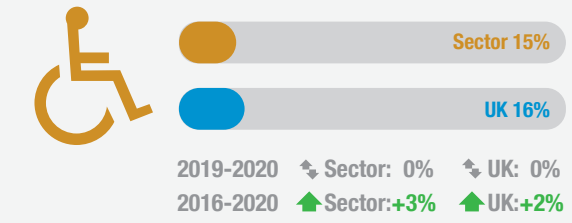

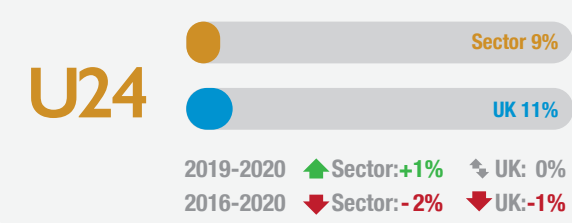
Percentage of Energy & Utilities Sector Workforce - Ethnic minority



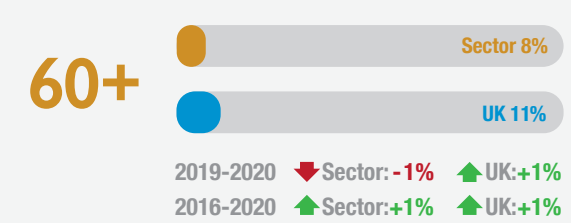
Percentage of Energy & Utilities Sector Workforce - Disabled



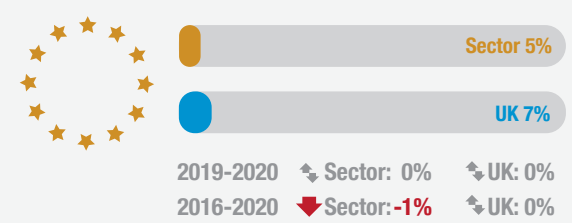
Percentage of Energy & Utilities Sector Workforce - Aged 16-24



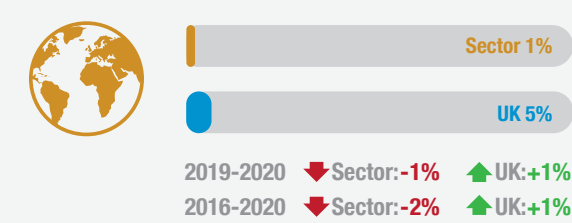
Percentage of Energy & Utilities Sector Workforce - 60+
