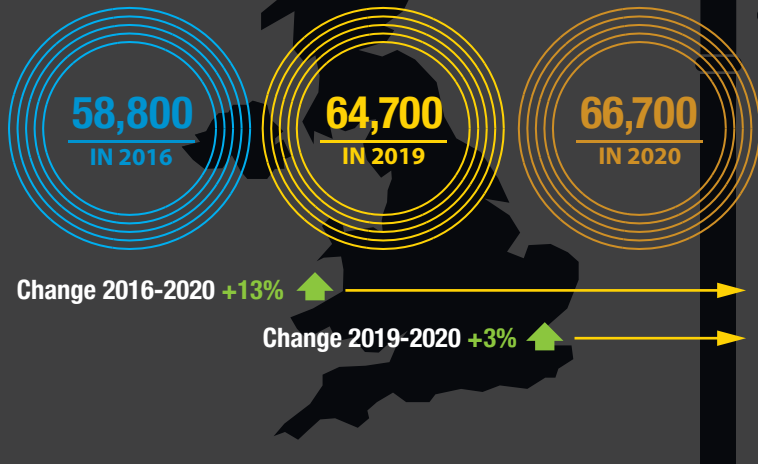

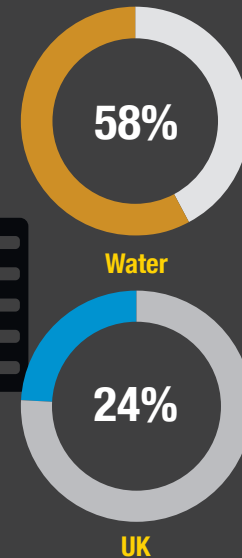

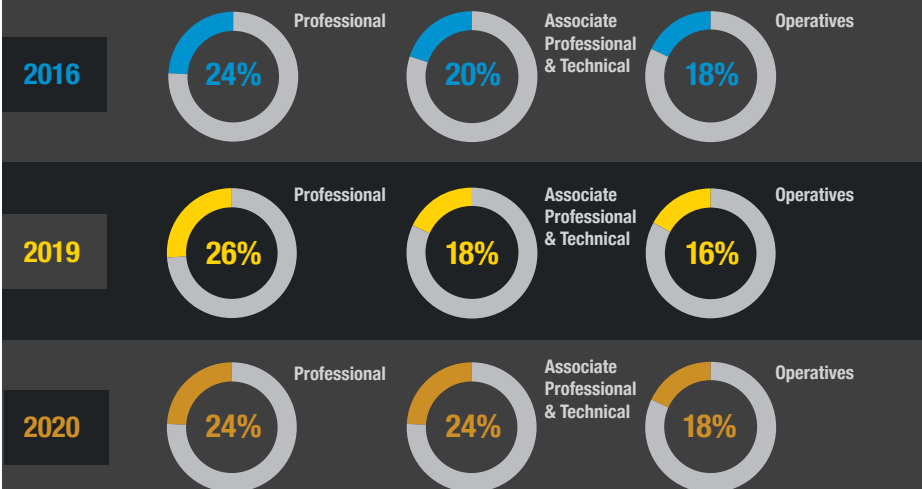


% OF VACANCIES THAT ARE SKILLS SHORTAGES 2019:

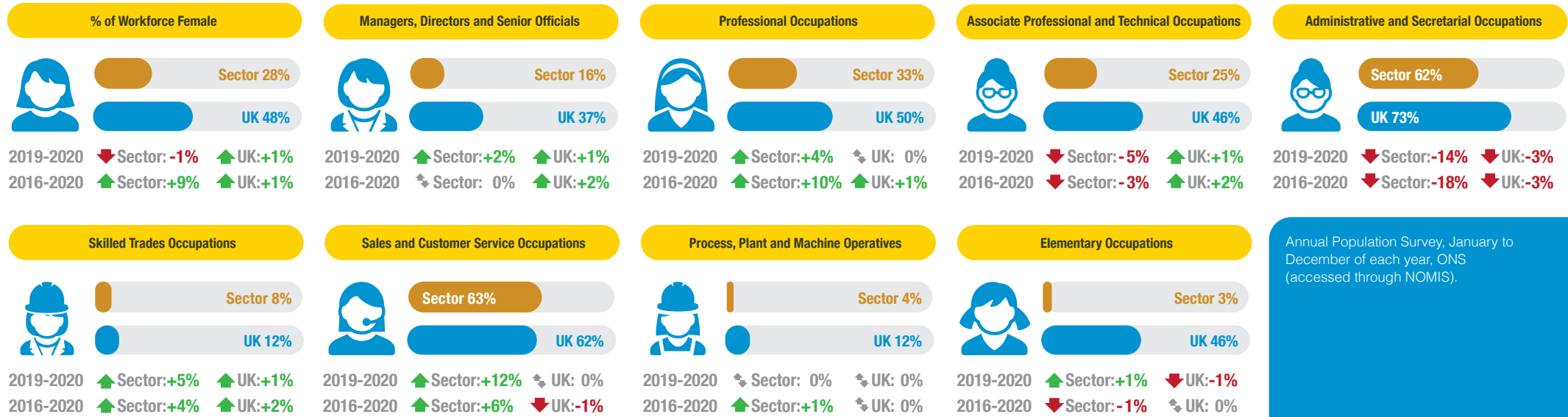
Forecast number of vacancies 2020-2029



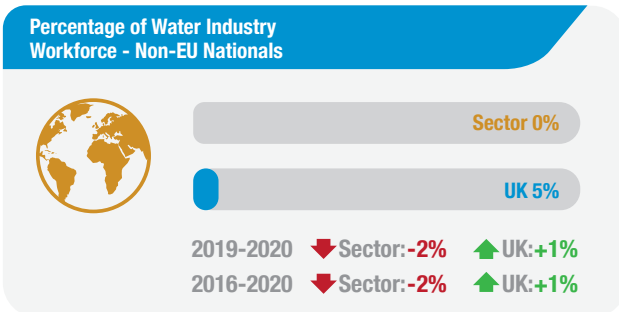
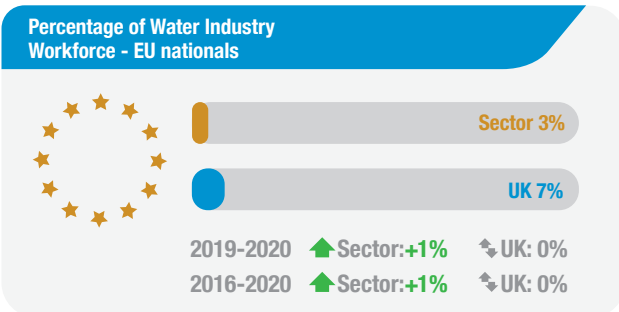
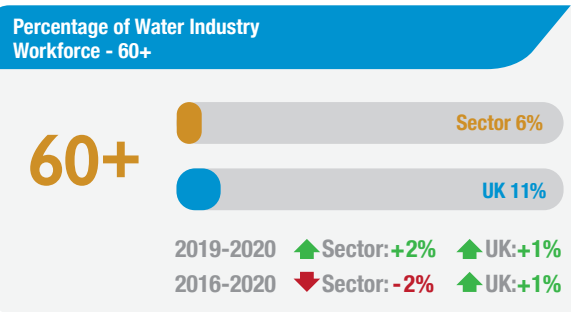
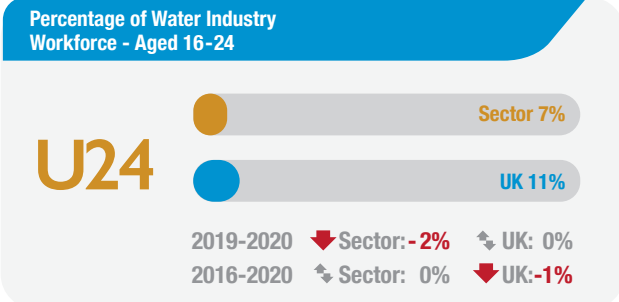
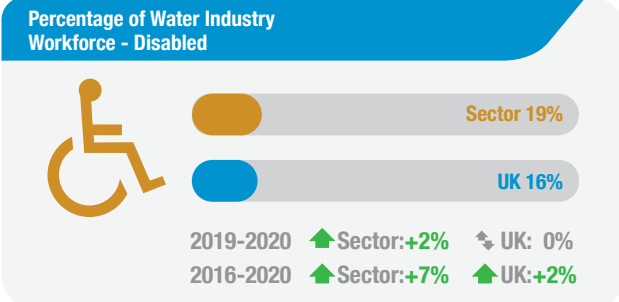
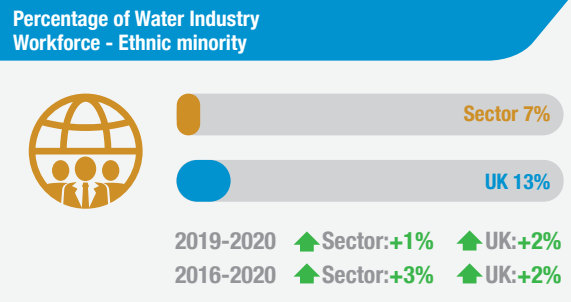
